Chinensis (<i>kousa</i>)	25' x 25'	Pure white/Late spring	OG specie, large & impressive, great bark & habit
Greensleeves (<i>kousa</i>)	20' x 20'	Green white/Late spring	Large greenish-white flowers, fruits for birds, disease resistant
Heart Throb (<i>kousa</i>)	25' x 15'	Rosey pink/Late spring	Heavy bloomer, fruits attract birds in fall, disease resistant
Milky Way Select (<i>kousa</i>)	20' x 20'	Pure white/Late spring	Super heavy bloomer, bushy & full of fruits for birds
Rosey Teacups (<i>kousa</i>)	25' x 20'	Bright pink/Late spring	Disease resistant, fruits attract birds & bushy, dense habit
Satomi (<i>kousa</i>)	20' x 20'	Med. pink/Late spring	Great Korean cultivar, disease resistant, fruits for the birds
Scarlet Fire (<i>kousa</i>)	20' x 20'	Fuchsia pink/Late spring	Vivid blooms, great fruits for the birds, superior disease resistance
Snow Tower (<i>kousa</i>)	15' x 8'	Pure white/Late spring	Huge flowers, narrower habit, disease resistant, fruits for birds
Stellar Pink (<i>kousa</i>)	25' x 20'	Blush pink/Mid spring	Fast growing, larger habit, disease resistant, no fruit
Summer Fun (<i>kousa</i>)	18' x 15'	Pure white/Late spring	Gorgeous variegated foliage, best in PM shade, fruits for the birds
Summer Gold (<i>kousa</i>)	15' x 10'	Pure white/Late spring	Striking gold/green foliage, disease resistant & smaller stature
Starlight (<i>C. kousa x nutallii</i>)	30' x 20'	Large white/Mid spring	Cross of Pacific/Korean dogwoods, disease resistant, fruits for birds
Venus (<i>C. kousa x nutallii</i>)	25' x 20'	Huge white/Mid spring	Cross of Pacific/Korean dogwoods, disease resistant, fruits for birds
Cornus mas	20' x 20'	Yellow/Early spring	Called "Cornelian Cherry", fruits are edible, nice early color
Saffron Sentinel (<i>C. mas</i>)	20' x 12'	Yellow/Early spring	Columnar Cornelian Cherry, tidy for modern landscapes
June Snow (<i>C. controversa</i>)	30' x 40'	White/Mid spring	Form of Giant Dogwood, impressive in flower & as a large specimen
Cherokee Brave (<i>C. florida</i>)	20' x 15'	Bright red/Mid spring	American Dogwood with darker flowers, give full sun & room
Cherokee Chief (<i>C. florida</i>)	20' x 15'	Bright red/Mid spring	Most popular "red" variety, give full sun & room to grow
Rubra (<i>C. florida</i>)	20' x 20'	Bright pink/Mid-spring	The traditional "Pink Dogwood", give full sun & room to grow

Ann	12' x 12'	Purple-pink/Mid spring	One of "The Girls" hybrids, multi stem tree form, slightly fragrant
Black Tulip	20' x 10'	Burgundy/Early spring	Darkest one around, impressive specimen tree for color & form
Burgundy Star	12' x 4'	Reddish/Mid spring	Slightly fragrant, great columnar habit for modern landscape
Butterflies	15' x 12'	Rich yellow/Mid spring	Slightly fragrant, large flowers, heavy bloomer before foliage
Felix Jury	20' x 8'	Hot pink/Early spring	Bright bloom color & heavy fragrance on this specimen tree
Genie	15' x 6'	Maroon purple/Mid spring	Slight fragrance, repeat flowers in fall on occasion, excellent habit
Jane	15' x 15'	Reddish pink/Mid spring	One of "The Girls" hybrids, multi stem tree form, slightly fragrant
M. soulangeana	25' x 25'	Rose pink/Mid spring	The OG "Tulip Tree", larger growing, old fashioned & fragrant
Rose Marie	12' x 8'	Bright pink/Mid-late spring	Later flower avoids frost, sweet fragrance & nice habit
Sunsation	25' x 10'	Gold pink/Mid spring	Unique color on large flowers, tidy pyramidal habit
Susan	12' x 12'	Red-purple/Mid spring	One of "The Girls" hybrids, multi stem tree form, slightly fragrant
Vulcan	20' x 15'	Magenta/Mid spring	Fragrant & huge flowers, impressive specimen tree
Baby Grand (Evergreen)	10' x 10'	White/Summer	Tidy dwarf form for small landscapes, super fragrant
Bracken Brown Beauty (Evergreen)	35' x 25'	White/Summer	Improved cold hardiness, fragrant blooms, large evergreen specimen
Kay Parris (Evergreen)	20' x 10'	White/Summer	Great dwarf with foliage color & fragrant blooms, hardy

Kwanzan (<i>serrulata</i>)	35' x 35'	Pink/Mid spring	Double flowers, vase shape structure, bronzy new growth
Mount Fuji (<i>serrulata</i>)	20' x 25'	White/Mid spring	Double flowers, slightly fragrant, nice spreading crown
Royal Burgundy (<i>serrulata</i>)	35' x 35'	Pink/Mid spring	Double flowers, vase shape, nice burgundy foliage
Snow Fountain (<i>weeping</i>)	15' x 12'	White/Mid spring	Single white flowers, nice umbrella form, prune to control size
Yoshino (<i>yedonensis</i>)	25' x 25'	White-pink/Early spring	Double & single flowers, slightly fragrant, nice vase shape

Evereste	20' x 20'	White/Mid spring	Disease resistant, 1" orangish fruit for birds, good grower
Golden Raindrops	20' x 15'	White/Mid spring	Disease resistant, serrated showy foliage, small golden fruits for birds
Ivory Spear	18' x 7'	White/Mid spring	Disease resistant, columnar form, red fruit for birds
Lollipop	8' x 8'	White/Mid spring	Disease resistant, red fruits for birds, tidy rounded form
Marilee	20' x 10'	White/Mid spring	Disease resistant, semi-double blooms, columnar shape, fruitless
Prairiefire	20' x 20'	Rose pink/Mid spring	Disease resistant, purplish-red fruit for birds, striking foliage color
Raspberry Spear	20' x 8'	Pink/Mid spring	Disease resistant, columnar form, striking foliage color, red fruits

Flame Thrower (Upright)	15' x 15'	Light pink/Early spring	Spectacular foliage color, yellows/oranges/reds all season, full sun
Golden Falls (Weeping)	10' x 4'	Lavender/Early spring	Orange to yellow foliage in spring, lime/golden in summer, nice form
Lavender Twist (Weeping)	6' x 6'	Lavender/Early spring	Clean green foliage, nice tidy habit on this specimen tree
Merlot (Upright)	20' x 20'	Bright pink/Early spring	Gorgeous purple foliage, loves heat & drought tolerant
Ruby Falls (Weeping)	8' x 6'	Lavender red/Early spring	Nice weeping habit, tidy for small landscapes, heart shaped foliage

Evening Light	15' x 10'	White/Mid-late spring	Fragrant, striking purplish foliage, best color in full sun location
Marley's Pink (Weeping)	10' x 6'	Pink/Mid-late spring	Fragrant, tidy weeping form adds interest, best in sunny spot
Nightfall (Weeping)	8' x 6'	White/Mid-late spring	Fragrant, unique purple foliage & weeping habit, excellent specimen
Snowcone	25' x 20'	White/Mid-late spring	Fragrant, uniform habit, less twig dieback than specie, best in full sun
Styrax japonica (species)	25' x 25'	White/Mid-late spring	Fragrant, larger specimen snowbell, impressive garden tree, full sun

Japanese (<i>S. pseudocamellia</i>)	35' x 25'	White/Mid summer	THE tree for all seasons, excellent specimen with fabulous bark

Catalpa (Purple & Gold)	30' x 30'	White/Mid spring	HUGE tropicalish foliage, provides shade, aka "Bean Tree"(don't eat)
Dove Tree (<i>Davidia</i>)	30' x 20'	White/Late spring	Most unusual white bract flowers fold over branches, choice variety
Franklinia (Ben Franklin Tree)	20' x 15'	White/Fall	Stunning to see in bloom with fall color, slow & rare
Goldenchain (<i>Laburnum</i>)	10' x 15'	Yellow/Mid spring	Green bark, heavy flowers, looks like yellow "Wisteria" to some
Serviceberry (<i>Amelanchier</i>)	20' x 20'	White/Early spring	Great native type for pollinators, fruits for birds, excellent fall color
Silk Tree/Mimosa (<i>Albizia</i>)	25' x 25'	Pink/Summer	Can choose green or dark purple foliage, slow & steady, full sun
Sourwood (<i>Oxydendron</i>)	30' x 20'	White/Late summer	One-of-a-kind blooming w/bright fall color, slow & steady specimen
Thundercloud Plum (<i>Prunus c.</i>)	20' x 20'	Light pink/Early spring	Dark purple foliage is nice, easy & common "street" tree

Many gardeners look for a “small” or “dwarf” flowering tree option, consider a large growing shrub for those landscape spots. This is a much better option than having to severely cut back a larger plant choice to fit into a smaller area. Many of the following shrub options can be found grafted in a tree form or trained into a single or multi-trunked specimen of small tree proportion.

Consider these: *Camellias* (evergreen and colorful spring blooms), *Contorted Filbert* (fun twisty branches and foliage), *Crape Myrtle* (bright summer bloom and great fall color), *Elderberry* (great foliage, late spring bloom and edible fruit), *Flowering Currant* (early spring color and hummingbird fav), *Lilacs* (super fragrant in spring), *PG Hydrangeas* (huge summer blooms and great fall color), *Pussy Willows* (early spring color and character), *Rose of Sharon* (excellent summer bloom), *Smoke Trees* (great foliage, fun poufy summer flowers and great fall color), *Snowball Viburnum* (white in late spring, showy and great fall color), *Wisteria* (stunning and fragrant late spring), *Witchhazel* (fragrant winter bloom and great fall color) and many others.

Remember: The best time to plant a tree was 20 years ago, the next best time is TODAY!

Availability changes throughout the season
