

Medium Light Houseplants

Plants can adapt easier to medium light. Many can even thrive since their natural habitats are shaded by tree canopies. Depending on how many hours of medium light you have available & the type of plant, legginess & lack of variegation can occur.

Keep in mind for plants, Light = Food

What is medium light?

- Direct East facing light
- 6-8 feet from an unobstructed South or West facing window
- Grow lights positioned midway from plant.
- Darker corners of a bright sunny room
- A room that only receives light for half of the day
